Hanne Tuntland:

Hanne Tuntland is a Norwegian occupational therapist with specialization in gerontology/geriatrics. She works as an Associate Professor at Bergen University College. Reablement has for several years been her main academic interest and research topic. She has been a coeditor/coauthor of a textbook in reablement. She is also involved in two research projects on reablement in Norway. Based on studies from the two research projects she intends to submit a doctoral thesis.

Magnus Zingmark:

Magnus Zingmark is head of research and development focusing on active and healthy ageing in the municipality of Östersund, Sweden. He has extensive experience from working with reablement as an occupational therapist. In 2015 he published his thesis “Occupation-focused and occupation-based interventions for community-dwelling older people – Intervention effects in relation to facets of occupational engagement and cost-effectiveness.”

Åse Brandt:

Åse Brandt is a senior researcher within the field of assistive technology at the National Board of Social Services in Denmark and an Associate Professor at the University of Southern Denmark. She has many years of experience within the field of assistive technology and is the co-editor/author of textbooks on assistive technology and on occupational therapy. Her research contributes to the evidence base of assistive technology interventions focusing on everyday activities and participation in society for people with disabilities and their satisfaction with their devices and the intervention process.

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
